

Fakse

Excellent peeling and consumption variety



Variety description

Consumption variety suitable for the fresh market and excellent for peeling. The variety has a very high yield potential and performs well, especially on sandy soils. Fakse has very good resistance to internal defects and produces well-shaped, oval tubers with yellow skin, shallow eyes and yellow flesh colour, which is greening slowly.

Growing advices

Please make sure to take Fakse out of the storage in due time before planting, so the tubers have a chance to adapt to the outside temperature.

Planting should not be done at soil temperatures below 8-10°C, and the soil needs to be well prepared to give the tubers the best growing conditions. Depending on the seed potato size, the tubers must be planted in a depth of 15-18 cm from the top of the ridge - the biggest tubers must go deepest.

Only apply fertilizer one time, and preferably at planting. Pay attention to the N dose because Fakse needs to mature by itself before haulm killing. Furthermore make sure that the potassium level in the soil is high enough to avoid discoloration after cooking, but also to improve the storability.

Fakse can be peeled late in the season - be aware of the dry matter content though - on the other hand it should not be peeled early in the season due to poor peeling result. Keep the potatoes in the dark to avoid greening.

Storage of seed potatoes: ≈ 4-6 °C

Storage of ware potatoes: ≈ 6-8 °C
