Table potato with peeling qualities from Danespo



Variety description

New medium-early consumption variety with smooth yellow skin, which can be grown on both clay and sandy soils with good yield. Especially on sandy soils it really impresses with high yields and a good skin finish compared to similar varieties. The variety has good cooking qualities, long-oval shape, and fits well into the ware, peeling and packing industries because of the nice yellow flesh colour. Frig has a good and wide resistance package.

Growing advice

Should not be planted directly from the mechanical cooling storage, as it needs to adjust to the temperature outside before planting.

Always plant in good weather and in good soil conditions. The soil temperature needs to be at least 8-10°C. Depending on the seed potato size, they should be planted in 10-16 cm depth - bigger tubers should go deeper.

Only apply fertilizer one time and preferably at planting. Furthermore make sure that the potassium level in the soil is high enough to avoid discoloration after cooking, but also to improve the storability.

Frig is rather quick in the emergence due to the earliness of the variety.

Good storability during the season, keep the potatoes in the dark to avoid greening.

Storage of seed potatoes: ≈ 4 °C

Storage of ware potatoes: ≈ 6-8 °C
