

# Plenty

A new dimension in baby potato production



## Variety description

Plenty makes an exceptionally high number of tubers per plant. As a grower you will harvest the most beautiful small oval tubers with the same firm consistency in each one of them in the size range from 15-40mm. This makes the variety unique together with the cooking qualities and tasty bite. Plenty has good storability, and can be stored into the spring. Preferably use a good sandy loam soil for growing, to ease the separation of soil and potatoes at harvest.

### Characteristics

- Usage: Consumption, salad, packing & washing
- Maturity: Medium early
- Yield: High yield of small tubers
- Foliage: Many stems, medium height
- Tuber size: Many small 15-40mm
- Tuber shape: Oval
- Number of tubers: 35-55
- Skin: Yellow, very smooth
- Flesh colour: Yellow
- Cooking type: A-AB
- Dry matter content: Medium to high
- Dormancy period: Medium to long
- Nematodes: Susceptible
- Wart disease: Susceptible
- Foliage blight: Medium resistance
- Tuber blight: Medium resistance
- Common scab: Medium resistance
- Virus Y: High resistance



## Growing advice

Plenty needs time to adapt to the outside temperature, so it should not be planted directly from mechanical cooling storage. When planted after having adjusted to the outside temperature, it has a rather quick emergence.

Always plant in good weather and in good soil conditions. The soil temperature should be at least 10°C. Depending on the seed potato size, they should be planted in 10-12 cms' depth - bigger tubers should go deepest.

Only apply fertilizer one time, and preferably at planting. Furthermore ensure that the potassium level in the soil is high enough to avoid discoloration after cooking, but also to improve the storability.

Plenty has very good virus Y resistance, which makes it easy to handle in the seed potato growing.

To keep the tubers suitable for consumption during the season, they should be kept in the dark to avoid greening.

Storage of seed potatoes: ≈ 4-6 °C

Storage of ware potatoes: ≈ 6-8 °C
